7:00 p.m. In the Plaza de la Constitución, a Solemn Eucharist will be celebrated by our Parish Priest, the Reverend Efreem Mira Pina. The 'Aromas de Guardamar Choir', directed by Jesús Aldeguer, will sing.

8:00 p.m. SOLEMN AND TRIUMPHAL PROCESSION with the image of Our Patron Saint, the Virgin of the Rosary, accompanied by Civil and Military Authorities, the Main Board of Brotherhoods, the Central Board of Moors and Christians and festival officials, the Lady of Guardamar and her companions 2026, the Bellea del Foc and the Bellea del Foc Infantil 2026 with their court of honor, the Queen and Children's Queen of the Country Festivals 2026 with their Ladies, accompanied by the Musical Group of Guardamar.

Itinerary : Plaza Constitución, Mayor, Valencia, Colón, San Jaime, Mar, San Francisco, Vicente Ramos and entrance to the temple, where after a few brief words from our Parish Priest the Hymn of Our Patron Saint the Virgin of the Rosary will be sung.

At the end, a large firework display will be set off in honor of Our Patron Saint in the Plaza de la Constitución.
